Dog License 2022

All dogs 7 months of age and older must be licensed and all licenses are to be renewed by January 31, 2022.
IF LICENSES ARE NOT RENEWED ON TIME A LATE FEE OF \$5.00 PER MONTH WILL
BE IMPOSED AFTER FEBRUARY 10TH.

Per State Law, a license cannot be issued if the current rabies vaccination expires before November 1, 2022.

If you are enrolled in the Sussex-Warren Area Energy Cooperative (SWAEC) Community Energy Aggregation Program please note, this program is ending on December 31, 2021. No Action is required on your part and your electric service will continue uninterrupted. Your electric supply will be returned to your local utility company, JCP&L, this will happen with the next meter reading on or after December 31, 2021. Any information about a new program will be mailed to eligible residents via First Class mail through the US Postal Service. Please remember that no one will call you or knock on your door with information regarding the SWAEC Community Energy Program.
