Brush Removal

Starting Monday, May 5th, the DPW
will begin Brush Removal
for WINTER DEBRIS ONLY

- Brush should be stacked with the ends piled neatly facing the road by 6:00am on May 5th.
- Only one pile of brush, 5 feet in length and 3 feet high per household will be accepted.
- Please leave limbs in lengths, not cut into pieces.
- No logs accepted over 2 inches in diameter.
- No construction materials of any kind are allowed.
- If the brush pile contains metal of any kind, it will be rejected, this included nails.
- Each road will canvassed only ONE time.
- Chips may be obtained at Wesley Field and Papa Park when available.


