DOG LICENSE

All dogs 7 months of age and older must be licensed. ALL licenses are to be renewed by **January 31, 2020**.

IF LICENSES ARE NOT RENEWED ON TIME

A LATE FEE OF \$5.00 PER MONTH WILL BE IMPOSED AFTER FEBRUARY 10TH.

If you do not renew the license, a court complaint/summons will be issued.

Per State Law, a license cannot be issued if the current rabies vaccination expires

before November 1, 2020

There is **NO PARKING** on any snow covered street in Green Township. Initial violation will result in a warning and any violation(s) thereafter will result in the towing of the vehicle.

REMINDER:

Top Tips for Keeping Your Pets Safe During a Disaster

If it's not safe for you to stay in your home during an emergency, it's not safe for them either!

Include supplies for your pet in your emergency kit, or assemble an emergency kit for your pet.

Make an evacuation plan for you and your pets. Many hotels and shelters do not accept animal guests, other than service animals.

Assemble an Emergency Kit for Your Pet

Keep items in an accessible place and store them in sturdy containers so that they can be carried easily.

Your kit should include:

- 1. Sturdy leashes, harnesses and/or carriers to transport pets safely and ensure that they can't escape.
- 2. Food, drinking water, bowls, cat litter/pan and a manual can opener if you pet eats canned food.
- 3. Medications and copies of medical records stored in a waterproof container.
- 4. A first aid kit.
- Current photos of you with your pet(s) in case they get lost. Since many pets look alike, this will help to eliminate mistaken identity and confusion.
- Information on feeding schedules, medical conditions, behavior problems, and the name and number of your veterinarian in case you have to foster or board your pets.
