### No Parking on Halloween

Parking on portions of Lake Tranquility Roads will be temporarily prohibited on Friday, October 31<sup>st</sup> from 6:00pm to 9:00pm

Please adhere to the following:

- No parking on lake-side of Shore Road, between Lakeview Drive and Scenic Drive.
- No parking on lake-side of Lakeview Drive, between Decker Pond Road and Forest Road.



This temporary restriction is solely for public safety purposes in connection with Halloween activities

### **Dog License 2026**

All dogs 7 months of age and older must be licensed and all licenses are to be renewed by January 31, 2026 IF LICENSES ARE NOT RENEWED ON TIME A LATE FEE OF \$5.00 PER DOG PER MONTH WILL BE IMPOSED AFTER FEBRUARY 10TH.

Per State Law, a license cannot be issued if the current rabies vaccination expires before
November 1, 2026. If you do not renew the license, a court complaint/summons will be issued.

## **Winter is Coming!**

#### EverGreen Park Bathrooms

The bathrooms at EverGreen Park will be closing on December 8<sup>th</sup> for the season. This closure prevents the pipes from freezing and is necessary for the protection of the systems. A temporary, handicap accessible bathroom will be available throughout the winter.



#### **Fire Hydrants**

Ordinance 17-2.7.1 Removal of Snow Around Fire Hydrants

The owner, owners or lessees of any real property in the Township abutting any fire hydrant shall maintain the area within a five-foot radius of the perimeter of any such fire hydrant free of snow. The removal of snow shall be completed within 24 hours of daylight after the snow has formed or fallen or accumulated on or around any fire hydrant. On failure to perform the required clearance within the specified time frame, the Township, or any department thereof, may perform the clearance and bill the responsible party no more than \$75.



# Snow plowing & shoveling

There will be NO plowing, shoveling, or snow blowing of snow INTO or ACROSS the roads. Please make sure all sidewalks on your property are cleared of snow within 24 hours of storm



There is **NO PARKING** on any road during snow storms, cars will be towed at owner's expense.



For any weather related emergencies regarding trees or wires across the roadway please call 908.852.3092 during and after business hours.

#### Winter Driving Safety Tips from the National Weather Service



## Don't crowd the plow. The road behind an active plow

is safer to drive on. Give them plenty of room to work and only pass when it is safe to do so.



Change the way you drive.

Drive slower than normal and leave more room between you and surrounding vehicles when roads are wet, snowy or icy. DO NOT use cruise control, brake quickly or take sharp turns.



Make sure you keep your gas tank over half full and keep a close eye on road conditions, which can change rapidly. On road trips, take breaks often so you can stay focused on the road.



#### **Check road conditions**

Call 511 or visit your state's DOT webpage to check on road conditions. Choose a different route or adjust your travel plans if road conditions are poor.



Stock your vehicle with a mobile phone, charger, batteries, blankets, flashlight, first-aid kit, high-calorie, non-perishable food, candle to melt snow for drinking water, sack of sand or cat litter for traction, shovel, scraper, and battery booster cables.



Get the weather forecast.

#### Ready your vehicle.

Check your battery, wipers, coolant, and other systems affected by cold temperature. Make sure your tires have good tread. Clear snow, ice or dirt from your windows, lights and camera



# RIVING SAFETY

#### Prevent a bad situation from getting worse.

If you're involved in an accident, try to pull your vehicle off the road and use hazard lights, flares, reflectors or flashlights to warn other drivers. STAY OFF THE ROAD, dial 911, and wait for the police to arrive. These actions can help prevent multi-vehicle crashes in winter weather.





texting or phone calls, speeding, or drug/alcohol use. These activities are always dangerous, but the risk is much higher in winter weather.

Wear your seatbelt.
Accidents happen more frequently with wet and icy roads. Always wear your seatbelt and ensure everyone in your vehicle does the same, including young children in proper car seats.


