The Weekend Bag is an initiative created and run by Green Township Resident, Isobel, now a Sophomore at Newton High School. Last year Isobel was a Freshman and excited to start her new adventure. School was great but as the weeks went on she started to notice a trend in conversations during the school day. Some of her peers were talking about going home and not having enough food or hygiene products that most teenagers don't ever have to worry about like soap, deodorant and toothpaste. A Junior Youth Ambassador for a nonprofit organization called Connect for Community (CFC) which shops and provides food and much needed hygiene products to over 40 food pantries, domestic abuse shelters and soup kitchens throughout Sussex County, Isobel brought up the issue at one of the CFC weekly meetings. She wanted to help and the President of CFC told her if she could come up with a plan they would support her.

Isobel and her CFC family shop for The Weekend Bag using the most amazing coupon skills and money obtained either through fundraising or donations. Isobel then gets the food to the school and requests help from school clubs (also helping these peers obtain the community service hours they need to graduate) to help her fill the bags with food, snacks and hygiene products. Then they deliver the bags to the guidance department and at the end of the week guidance will contact the kids participating to come pick up their bags which they take home and return empty on Monday. And the process starts all over for the next weekend.
