

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAYS
SATURDAY June 3 November 4 7AM - 2PM

Limits: 100 pounds of dry household hazardous waste materials, 25 fluorescent bulbs, and/or 10 gallons of liquid waste for free

Examples of waste include: lead & oil based paints, stains, paint thinner, fuel oils, lubricants, pool chemicals, mercury, hazardous batteries, fluorescent bulbs



The SCMUA conducts two household hazardous waste events annually, usually in the spring and fall. This program is available to Sussex County residents, local school districts, municipalities and county agencies. The SCMUA conducts these special events because it removes from the waste stream pollutants and toxins that would otherwise find their way into landfill and the leachate generated.

YOU MAY BRING UP TO 100 POUNDS OF DRY HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE MATERIALS AND/OR 10 GALLONS OF LIQUID WASTE - FREE OF CHARGE ON THE ABOVE DATES ONLY.

LATEX (WATER BASED) PAINT IS NOT HAZARDOUS
IT CAN BE BROUGHT TO THE AUTHORITY AS REGULAR GARBAGE @ 13
CENTS PER POUND AT THE RESIDENTS' CONVENIENCE CENTER
FOR LARGER QUANTITIES TRUCK SCALE CHARGE FOR BULK WASTE

THE FOLLOWING ARE EXAMPLES OF HAZARDOUS WASTE THAT CAN
ONLY BE BROUGHT ON THE DESIGNATED HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS

DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ON HHW DAY:

PENTACHLOROPHENOLENE
EXPLOSIVES
SILVEX
PCB'S OR PCB MATERIALS
PICRIC ACID
