LETTER FROM THE MAYOR

At long last, spring is finally here! I hope everyone is enjoying the longer days and warmer weather. How nice it is to see everyone out and about in the park and on our trails.

Good news regarding the popular County Connector Trail. The Township will begin expanding the trail to the north this spring. Our Department of Public Works will begin clearing north of Creek Road through the former Trinca Airport property adding about a mile of new trail.

The Township is planning a road improvement project to White Hall Road between County Route 517 and County Route 603. Almost half the project cost is being paid for through a NJDOT grant that was awarded to the Township. The project includes raising a low-lying section of the roadway to prevent flooding of the roadway that has occurred in recent years.

Please don't forget to support our first responder volunteer organizations: Allamuchy-Green First Aid Squad and Green Township Fire Department. You count on them to help you during times of emergency...they count on you for financial support to help maintain their facilities and equipment. And they are always looking for new volunteers.

Woodchipping Program

Starting Monday, May 3rd the Road Department will conduct a woodchipping program for WINTER DEBRIS ONLY

- Brush should be stacked with the ends piled neatly facing the road by 6:00am on May 3rd.
- Only one pile of brush, 5 feet in length and 3 feet high, per household will be accepted.
- Please leave limbs in lengths, not cut into small pieces.
- No logs accepted over 2 inches in diameter.
- No construction materials of any kind are allowed.
- If the brush pile contains metal of any kind it will be rejected, this includes nails.
- Each road will be canvassed only ONE TIME.
- Chips may be obtained at Wesley Field and Papa Park.

Did you pick up a tree seedling at Town Hall?

If you want to give your new seedling a fighting chance we suggest planting it in a one gallon container. Prior to filling with good potting soil, place a few rocks in the bottom to ensure proper drainage. Fertilize as required. Mulch may be added to the top but be sure to keep it away from the stem. Water and leave outside in or close to the area where it will be planted. Repeat process using two gallon container or plant in its final location. Continue to water and fertilize until established. Mulch as required to keep area weed free. Remember to be mindful of the tree's ultimate size and plant accordingly.

Zoning Permit FAQ's

What is a Zoning Permit? A zoning permit is permission from the Township for WHERE you want place a structure such a pool, fence, or shed on your property.

Why do I need a Zoning Permit? You need a Zoning permit to ensure you are not encroaching on your neighbors property and they are not encroaching on yours. Also, to help keep your neighborhood aesthetically pleasing.

When do I need a Zoning Permit? A zoning permit is needed for pools (both above ground and in-ground), pole barns, detached garages, sheds, fences, decks, solar panels (including rooftop), standing generators, small greenhouses, additions, running a business out of your home, change of use and finishing a basement. This is NOT a complete list of what you need a zoning permit for, ONLY a list of the most common requests.

Why do I need a Zoning Permit to finish my basement? The quick answer is to make sure you aren't adding a bedroom or two. Homes are built to certain standards when it comes to the septic system. For example, if your home was built with 3 bedrooms then the septic system is rated for 3 bedrooms only. If you add a bedroom anywhere in the house you will need to go to the Sussex County Department of Health to upgrade your septic system.

Why do I need a permit to run a business out of my home? This is needed to regulate the intensity of the use on the property.

What do I need to submit a Zoning Permit? You will need to fill out the application which can be picked up at town hall or found on our website www.greentwp.com, under zoning. Along with a copy of a survey for your property to show where, exactly, you are placing the structure, you will need a check made out to Green Township in the correct amount. The fee schedule is listed on the zoning permit.

How do I submit a Zoning Permit application? Once you have everything required, you can submit your application by dropping it off at Town Hall either in person or by using the marked drop box by the front door OR you can mail it to PO Box 65, Tranquility, NJ 07879.

How will I know if my application was approved or denied? If approved, you will receive your permit via email or regular mail. If denied, you will receive a letter of denial via email or regular mail.

What do I do if my application is denied? If denied, you have the option to move the structure to an area that will allow for the approval or you can request a variance from the Land Use Board. For Land Use Board questions please contact Kim at landuse@greentwp.com or 908-852-9333 x13.

Who is the Zoning Officer and how do I contact him? Craig Bollmann is the Zoning Officer and the best way to contact him is through email at zoning@greentwp.com. You can also reach him in person, Wednesday 10:00am - 12:00pm and Friday 8:30am - 3:30pm or by phone 908-852-9333 x 17.
