Green Township is situated in the southeast corner of Sussex County. It was formed when the then larger county was divided, in 1824, to create Warrren County.

There are four unincorporated villages or hamlets. **GREENDELL** (formerly Greensville, settled in 1770 and once called Lincoln); **HUNTSVILLE**;

TRANQUILITY (formerly Kennedytown or Canadatown - no one knows where the latter name came from, but the Kennedys ran the mill in town). The name Tranquility was taken from the name of the Methodist Church in the village and Tranquility seemed more suitable than Kennedytown; HUNT'S MILL (sometimes called Washington).

What is the full name of the railroad that built the Lackawanna Cut-Off?

Bonus Question #1: Of the 12 original overhead bridges that carried roads over the Cut-Off, only one has been removed that will not be replaced. Where was that bridge located?

<u>Bonus Question #2:</u> What is the name of the tunnel on the Lackawanna Cut off?

Family Fun Night - Gingerbread Contest Every child that built a house was awarded a building permit based on their creativity and construction skills. Fun was had by all!






Green Township


