Habitat is researching the lots for possibility of building a house. The Township Attorney reviewed the parameters for spending the affordable housing trust fund and provided the deadline dates. A discussion ensued regarding the affordable housing requirements with deed restrictions and what is the best way to spend the monies. The Committee agrees that the feasibility study provided valuable information; however, the consensus of the Committee is that Green Township is not in a position at this time to move forward with the stormwater utility.

Student Government Day Thank You Letters - We have received a plethora of thank you letters from students at the Green Hills School concerning Student in Government Day. These well written letters have been distributed for your reading pleasure.

Concept Plan Former Trinca Airport - We have received a conceptual plan to place a warehouse building on the site of the former Trinca Airport. This plan has been placed on the dais and we are requesting comments concerning said plan.

A discussion ensued regarding the conceptual plan. It was the consensus of members present that a 400,000 square foot building was too large of a building for said site and directed the Township Clerk to explore revenue options for this property.

Solar at Trinca - As discussed in the past there is a potential path forward for a solar project adjacent to the former Trinca Airport. Virtual Net Metering is a potential program, but this specific portion of the property must be removed from the AG Development Area. We have made said request to Sussex County Agricultural Development Board, who will consider the Township's request at their June 17, 2024, meeting.

Clean Communities Grant - The Township received a check for \$16,267.56 in 2024 grant monies for Clean Communities. These funds are utilized for street sweeper brushes, pet waste collection boxes, rubbish containers in Township parks, and all Clean Communities Day expenses.

Request to Hang Banner - Newton High School would like to honor their Senior graduates with a banner in each sending district. They are currently looking at a 4X8 banner to be displayed near the Kennedy Road/County Route 517 intersection. Once received we will display the banner along Kennedy Road in front of EverGreen Park.

Cell Tower - Mayor Phillips asked for an update on the cell tower. The Township Clerk explained he is waiting on their engineers to calculate that location and height. Once calculated a balloon will go up and the Committee can then examine the location.

MATTERS FROM THE GOVERNING BODY:

Qarmout expressed his dissatisfaction and apologies for having missed Student Government Day this year. Qarmout asked if Kennedy Road was slated for new blacktop. The Township Clerk explained that Kennedy Road is a county road. Green Township does not have jurisdiction over the county roads.

De Young thanked everyone that participated in Green Township Day. Congratulations to the new Miss Green.

Mayor Phillips commented that Student Government Day was very successful. Mayor Phillips gave kudos to Green Township Day and everyone that helped make it a great day! Mayor Phillips stated that a joint legislative resolution was presented by Assemblyman Inganamort to the Township which will be framed to be hung in the municipal building. Mayor Phillips reminded everyone that the Bicentennial BBQ Pig Roast tickets are on sale.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION OF \$245,000.00 FOR THE PREPARATION AND EXECUTION OF A COMPLETE PROGRAM OF REASSESSMENT OF REAL PROPERTY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY FOR THE USE OF THE LOCAL ASSESSOR OF THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Sussex County Board of Taxation has ordered the Township of Green, New Jersey (the "Township") to implement a municipal-wide reassessment of real property in the Township to be completed by October 1, 2024, and to go into effect for the 2025 tax year; and

WHEREAS, the Local Budget Law of New Jersey and in particular N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53, provides that a municipality may adopt an ordinance authorizing a special emergency appropriation for, among other things, the preparation and execution of a complete program of revaluation of real property for the use of the local assessor when such is ordered by the County Board of Taxation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREEN IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A special emergency appropriation in the amount of \$245,000.00 is hereby authorized and made for the purpose of the preparation and execution of a complete program of reassessment of real property in the Township of Green, New Jersey for the use of the local assessor of the Township.

Section 2. The Township hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to finance such appropriation from surplus funds available or by issuing special emergency notes from time to time in accordance with the provision of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55, all as shall be determined by and pursuant to a resolution or resolutions of the Township to be hereafter adopted.

Section 3. In accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53, a copy of this ordinance as adopted shall be filed with the Director of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect after publication after final adoption, as provided by law.
