The Recreation Advisory Committee held a regular meeting on April 20, 2021 virtually through Go To Meeting and it began at 7:05pm.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS:

Neighbors Teaching Neighbors – Kim did not release the information or post this program in the Grapevine because she felt it was not ready to put out there yet. We do have a few classes on deck but the details still need to be figured out as to whether they will be done online or in person and whether it will be geared towards children or adults. There are still more details to figure out and will be discussed further at the next meeting.

Miss Green – After a long discussion, the video submission by each contestant will be no longer than 3 minutes and should be creative. Colleen will send Kim a list of criteria and any wording changes to the application and Kim will get it out to the High Schools, the Post offices, park and on social media.

Unfulfilled Recreational Needs – There are potential grant funds available to us to use for recreational needs. Kim had already submitted for the Movie Screen, audio equipment and generator needed for drive in movies. Other ideas that Kim will add to the list are a barricade in front of the bathrooms at the park during events for safety. Electrical cord covers, tables, chairs and small pop-up tents. The grant will be submitted, and we will wait to see the items were approved.

Review of the Park Rules for the Township Committee – The Rec Committee reviewed the park rules and came up with a couple of suggestions that will be forwarded to the Township Committee for review. Kim will submit a memo to Mark Zschack to forward to the TC. Those changes included:

Under “Prohibited Activities”

- [5] to read “Utilize any Township owned facilities from an **organized group or organization**, including fields, without prior approval from the Township, per Township Code section 9-15

- [10] to read Possess of bring any glass containers into any facility and removed “**glass objects**”

To also include the park is being monitored by video surveillance and if anyone is found violating the property in any way, they should be held financially accountable to fix any damage done.
