MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK: Mr. Zschack noted the following matters:

Student Government Day - This year Student Government Day is scheduled for Monday, May 20th with the student essays focusing on Green Township's Bicentennial.

Louis Bay 2nd Future Municipal Leaders Scholarship Competition - This is the 30th year the League of Municipalities has sponsored the Luis Bay scholarship. On February 1st letters will be sent to the four area high schools announcing this competition.

Stormwater Utility Grant - Before today there seemed to be a lot of confusion between DEP and the Engineering firm on how this grant would benefit Green Township. Today was the kickoff meeting with NJDEP and Arcadis Engineering concerning the stormwater grant. Representing Green Township was Cory Stoner, Jason Miller, and myself. As previously thought, this study is not limited to Lake Tranquility but includes the entire Township. The location of stormwater assets is NOT included in the study, but valuable financial and maintenance information will be obtained. The downside is we now need to provide a lot of financial and physical information so the study can get started.

Gas Main Install - The gas main installation continues along Pequest, Phillips and Mackerley Roads. This week's work will be along Mackerley Road due to the logistics with the Pequest Road crossing. Unknown drainage was discovered on the planned route near the intersection of Phillips and Pequest Roads. My assessment of the traffic control is that it appears to be moving smoothly whenever I traverse the work site.

Township Wide Reassessment - We have been notified that the order for the Township wide property reassessment will arrive sometime in March.

DPW - The DPW crew has been working nonstop dealing with multiple storms. This past storm was very challenging due to a number of issues. The biggest factor was the very cold temperatures that swooped in quickly. Adding to the logistics was equipment failure that not only affects the plow route but removes an employee to make said repair. There was also a concern with diesel fuel deliveries which added to Jason's worries and workload.

Recreation Committee Recommendation - On January 16th during their reorganization meeting, the Recreation Committee discussed Green Township Day. Their recommendation is to move this event from September to June 1, 2024. This recommendation includes the removal of the Summer BBQ that was normally held in June.

A discussion ensued regarding Green Township Day being held in June with concerns of other events occurring in June as well. The Deputy Clerk explained that prom, graduation dates and sports events were considered. In addition, the Miss Green Township Scholarship Competition will be held in conjunction with Green Township Day. A resolution with Spring Recreation events will be considered at the next Township Committee meeting.

Rose asked about events planned throughout the year. The Deputy Clerk provided the dates and events that the Bicentennial Committee are planning. The Committee asked to see a calendar of events.

Rose thanked the Road Department despite all their challenges the roads looked good, thank you for all their efforts with the recent storms.

DeYoung noted the number of trees down and thanked the Road Department.

Qarmout also thanked the Road Department and the Fire Department with assisting a neighboring town with the recent fire.

Raffay commented that the Road Department did a great job and commented on the Fire Department's time frame attending to a recent barn fire.

TOWNSHIP OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:4-45.1 *et seq.*, provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-44.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Green in the County of Sussex finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2024 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$104,661.59 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Green, in the County of Sussex, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2024 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Green shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$104,661.59, and that the CY 2024 municipal budget for the Township of Green be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,
