 - A preliminary concept plan from the Township Engineer for the extension of the County Connector Trail crossing Kennedy Road connecting to Allamuchy.
 - Mr. Caruso noted that Mr. Perigo has been doing a fantastic job clearing the trail from Creek Road to Airport Road. There is large amount of contaminated railroad ties that will need to be removed. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9-9, MAINTENANCE AND USE OF FACILITIES, TO INCLUDE A NEW SUBSECTION (d) ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL TOWNSHIP FACILITIES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Green that Section 9-9 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Green is hereby amended to add a new subsection (d) establishing rules and regulations of all Township facilities as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 9-9, Maintenance and Use of Facilities, shall be revised by addition of a new subparagraph (d) as follows:

(d) The Township Committee shall have the authority to promulgate and publish rules and regulations governing use of all Township facilities for the safety and well-being of the general public.

SECTION 2 - SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3 - REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are inconsistent or in opposition to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication in accordance with law.
