The Interlocal Agreement will be on the agenda for the reorganizational meeting on January 2, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. for the Committee's consideration.

Mrs. Phillips answered that Requests for Interest have been received, the deadline was December 14, 2018. The Expressions of Interest have not yet been reviewed. Public meetings are expected to take place in 2019.

Mr. Charles Mitchell, 15 Willow Terrace, wished everyone a Merry Christmas and a Happy Holiday. Mr. Mitchell stated that he is concerned about the well being drilled at the nextdoor property appears to be very close to the property line, possibly less than 5 feet. Mr. Mitchell is concerned of his well going dry.

Mrs. Marie Bilik, Highland Avenue, thanked Mayor Conkling and the Township Committee for the nomination to be one of Congressman Gottheimer's Hometown Heroes. She was very honored and humbled to be part of the ceremony.

The Committee congratulated and thanked Mrs. Bilik.

Mr. Charles Mitchell, 15 Willow Terrace, asked about natural gas in the lake community. Mrs. Phillips explained that based upon the surveying previously done by Elizabethtown Gas, there had not been a tremendous amount of interest. In order for it to be cost effective, there needs to be a number of people sequentially that would be interested to tie into the natural gas line.

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ASSEMBLY BILL A4037 AND SENATE BILL S2650
AMENDING N.J.S.40A:14-96, N.J.S.40A:14-98 AND P.L.1940, c. 153
ALLOWING MEMBERS OF JUNIOR FIREFIGHTERS' AUXILIARIES
TO PERFORM CERTAIN FIRE SUPPORT DUTIES

WHEREAS, fire departments are in dire need of volunteers and have requested amendments to current legislation to help recruit and maintain volunteer firefighters; and

WHEREAS, junior firefighters provide key support to volunteer fire departments in Sussex County and throughout New Jersey, and these departments are lacking the ability to utilize junior firefighters during non-hazardous duties at fire scenes and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, **Assembly Bill 4037** and **Senate Bill 2650** provide much needed amendments to current legislation to allow junior firefighters to perform support and training by establishing guidelines allowing junior firefighters the ability to perform certain non-hazardous duties during training, activities at the scene of a fire or other emergencies based on the age of the member; and

WHEREAS, **Assembly Bill 4037** and **Senate Bill 2650** will help expand opportunities for junior volunteer firefighters thereby encouraging youth in our communities to get involved where they live and volunteer for volunteer fire departments and expand their ability to learn and train among seasoned volunteers with the hope they will continue to volunteer as adults in their community.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Township Committee of the Township of Green hereby supports amending N.J.S.40A:14-96, N.J.S.40A:14-98 and P.L. 1940, c.153 as provided for in **Assembly Bill 4037** and **Senate Bill S2650** allowing members of junior firefighter auxiliaries to perform certain fire support duties based on the age of the member.
