Mayor Conkling recognized Mr. Brian Waddell in the audience. Mr. Waddell met with Mayor Conkling and Deputy Mayor Phillips in reference to the Sussex County Solid Waste Advisory Committee. At the reorganizational meeting in

January, Mr. Waddell will be recommended as the representative for Green Township. Mayor Conkling welcomed Mr. Waddell.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK: Mr. Zschack noted the following matters:

Public Wi-Fi

The public Wi-Fi is up and running with access throughout the building and in some areas of the parking lot.

Garbage RFP

The Township only received one bid in response to the Solid Waste and Bulky Item Collection RFP from Waste Management. There were five options submitted and all are under review. If the five-year option was chosen there would be a \$33,708 yearly increase.

Whitehall Road

Construction Costs = \$315,000 Engineering Design = \$15,000 Construction Inspection = \$10,000 Roadway Cores = \$2,000 Total Estimated Costs = \$342,000

Minus NJDOT Grant = \$160.00

Township Share = \$182,000

The \$182,000 would wipeout all capital monies for road improvement and \$30,000 in other purchases. The CFO and I agree that we could afford the use \$110,000 of capital money toward Whitehall Road. The Township Engineer will submit to the Township Committee a reduced scale of the project for review before sending to the NJDOT for approval. There is also the option of performing the work in 2021 so capital monies could be put aside for two years to cover the cost. Mr. Zschack will research other grants that may be available in addition to the NJDOT grant monies.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY: Mrs. Leo noted no matters for discussion.

MATTERS FROM THE MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT HEAD: Not in attendance.

OPEN PUBLIC SESSION #2:

Mrs. Katherine Rodriguez, 289 Pequest Road stated that she has noticed a number of zoning violations with commercial businesses in her neighborhood. Mayor Conkling suggested Mrs. Rodriquez contact the Zoning Official so that he can investigate the properties.

Mrs. Marge Vivian, 12 Hunts Pond Road concerned about speeding on her street. Mayor Conkling explained that the Township Engineer did inspect the road and does not recommend speed bumps on the road due to site distance. Mr. Zschack stated that signs have been ordered and will be installed. Letters have been sent to the State Police as well as the Sheriff's Department.

Mrs. Josephine Fracasso, 111 Hibler Road thought that the Township was not participating in farmland preservation. Mr. Chirip explained the farmland preservation for any resident that wants to apply. We will use Open Space funds to buy the easement. Mr. Chirip explained the preservation process.

TOWNSHIP OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NJ

AN ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPTER II, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE VI, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREEN

WHEREAS, the Green Township Committee has reviewed the current Township Code regarding the Department of Works and revisions are necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Green, Sussex County, New Jersey, that Chapter II, Administration, Article VI, Department of Public Works shall be revised as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 2-16.2 "Supervisor of Public Works" shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

2-16.2 Department of Public Works Department Head

The Township Committee shall appoint the Department of Public Works Department Head, who shall report to the Township Clerk concerning matters of operation, personnel, planning, citizen inquiries, complaints or requests for assistance and such other matters pertaining to the Department which will enable the Clerk to exercise his/her responsibilities to the Committee. The Department Head shall also have authority to manage and allocate the Public Works Department personnel, subject to the review of the Township Committee.

SECTION 2.

Section 2-16.3 "Appointment of Road Supervisor and Personnel" shall be deleted in its entirety.

SECTION 3-SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4 - REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are inconsistent or in opposition to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication in accordance with law.
