**MATTERS FROM THE GOVERNING BODY:** Mr. Chirip stated that he will not be able to attend the Township Committee Meeting on March 2, 2020.

Mr. Conkling asked Mr. Perigo about the salt supply since we have not had much snow. Mr. Perigo responded that there is plenty of salt and that he will order more in March in order to have a full supply while the price is good.

Mr. Qarmout asked for the status of the third-party electric co-op. Mr. Zschack stated that it has been renewed. Mr. Qarmout asked if we have an idea of the number of residents that are in the co-op and how many opted out. Mr. Zschack responded that those numbers are not known and not controlled by Green Township.

Mr. Qarmout asked for a status update for the Lake Tranquility drainage improvement study. Mr. Zschack stated that the Township Engineer has started working on a plan however has been involved with many other projects.

#### MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK: Mr. Zschack noted the following matters:

<u>Trinca Airport</u> – Mr. Pete Sklannik and Mr. Zschack met with two representatives from New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) concerning the closure of Trinca Airport. After a final check of documents by NJDOT, it is now determined that the final payback date is September 22, 2020. This will result in an amended closing date to September 30, 2020. The two forms, (DA-3 & 7480-1) that Mr. Sklannik will file will reflect this new date. Before submission these documents will be forwarded to the Township Committee for review.

<u>Playground</u> - An inspection of the EverGreen Park playground by the Township's Risk Manager has specified some safety concerns. The rubber covering on all of the chains for the swings are damaged and are creating sharp surfaces. The protective coating covering the decking and steps has failed therefore creating sharp edges and tripping hazards. The report states "until corrected the playground should be closed." On Friday the DPW removed the swings and closed off the playground equipment with orange fencing. Last year the decking was treated to try to prevent this delamination but the process failed. The capital plan has indicated the replacement of the playground this year, but unfortunately this has accelerated the time frame. Once a final plan is approved, we can expedite the construction through a Co-op or State Contract. Mr. Zschack met with a representative and the 2016 plan will be upgraded to 2020 standards.

Mayor Conkling asked if any of the open space monies be used to fund a portion of the playground. The Township Attorney will review the language of the ordinance.

Mr. Zschack stated that JCP&L appears to be expanding their criteria for removing trees. JCP&L has flagged trees on Meadow Lane that will be taken down. This is a savings as the thought was that the Township would have to take the trees down.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY: Mrs. Leo noted no matters to report.

**MATTERS FROM THE MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT HEAD:** Mr. Perigo stated the DPW is almost complete with brush cleanup.

**OPEN PUBLIC SESSION #2:** Mrs. Laura Bugay, 3 Fieldview Road, commented on the building on Airport Road across from the airport property. The concerns include tree removal and bright outside lights. Mrs. Bugay provided a handout to the Committee showing her concerns. Mayor Phillips stated that the issue will be brought to the Zoning and Construction Official's attention.

Mr. Bugay provided three additional handouts that provided information about marijuana energy impact, molds, trees and wild animals. Mr. Zschack stated that copies will be provided to the Township Committee.

Mr. John Skorski, 124 Creek Road, asked if the Committee has thought about bringing in another group to help bring other business in to the town. Mayor Phillips stated that it has not been discussed recently. Mr. Skorski commented that the Township should consider having a festival on the airport property or a road race through the township. The Committee stated that Mr. Skorski can bring his ideas to the Recreation Committee.

Ms. Patty Cammisa, 36 Hillside Terrace, stated concerns about the new garbage contract. Mayor Phillips explained that costs have increased due to countries longer taking our recycling. Ms. Cammisa offered concerns about trees that are not on her property that could cause damage. Mr. Zschack asked her to send an email showing her concerns so the Township can look into it.

Ms. Carol Hardcastle, 5 Meadow Lane expressed concerns about some of the trees on Meadow Lane and is pleased to hear that JCP&L will be addressing the issue.

Ms. Mary Konzelmann, 17 Sunset Drive, stated that there is a large amount of grit near the Lake Tranquility Dam Bridge. Mr. Zschack responded that a dam inspection is scheduled for next month.

Mr. Laura Bugay, 3 Fieldview Road, offered comments on the medical marijuana ordinance.

Mr. David Nazaire, 8 Mountain View Drive, stated that he is a lifeguard at the indoor pool at the Tranquility Camp. Mr. Nazaire asked about the possibility of opening the pool for the public's use. Mayor Phillips asked Mr. Nazaire to contact the Zoning Official so that he can review the application and the approvals.

There being no further public comments, Mayor Phillips closed Open Session #2.

# ORDINANCE NO. 2020-03 TOWNSHIP OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

# AN ORDINANCE REVISING SECTION 2-32, "EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL", OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREEN

**WHEREAS**, the Green Township Committee has reviewed the current Township Code regarding the Emergency Management Coordinator and Emergency Management Council and found that revisions are necessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Green, Sussex County, New Jersey, that Chapter II, Administration, Article X, Office of Emergency Management, Sections 2-32.1 and 2-32.6, shall be revised as follows:

#### SECTION 1.

Section 2-32.1 "Creation of Office", that reads:

#### 2-32.1 Creation of Office.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. Appendix A:9-40.6, et seq., the Township Committee shall appoint an Emergency Management Coordinator who shall be a resident of the Township for three (3) years.

Shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

#### 2.32.1 Creation of Office

In compliance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> Appendix A:9-40.1, the Township Mayor shall appoint an Emergency Management Coordinator, who shall be a resident of the Township for three (3) years. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall serve a three (3) year term and shall fulfill the requirements of applicable law.

#### **SECTION 2.**

Section 2.32.6 "Emergency Management Council", that reads:

#### 2-32.6 Emergency Management Council.

An Emergency Management Council shall be created. The Emergency Management Council shall be composed of not more than fifteen (15) members who shall be appointed by the Township Committee and shall hold office at the will and pleasure of the Township Committee. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall be a member and shall serve as chairman of the Emergency Management Council. The Emergency Management Council shall perform such duties as required in accordance with the State Statutes and pursuant to the Emergency Management Master Plan on file at the Township of Green.

Shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

#### 2.32.6 Emergency Management Council.

An Emergency Management Council shall be created. The Emergency Management Council shall be composed of not more than fifteen (15) members who shall be appointed by the Township Mayor and shall hold office at the will and pleasure of the Township Committee. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall be a member and shall serve as Chairman of the Emergency Management Council. The Emergency Management

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Council shall perform such duties as required in accordance with the State Statutes and pursuant to the Emergency Management Master Plan on file at the Township of Green.

#### SECTION 3.

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

#### **SECTION 4.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are inconsistent or in opposition to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed in their entirety.

#### **SECTION 5**.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication and passage according to law.

#### NOTICE

The above entitled Ordinance was introduced and passed at first reading by the Green Township Committee at a meeting held on February 19, 2020, and after publication and a public hearing was finally adopted by the Green Township Committee at a meeting held on March 2, 2020.
