a. Bear Relocation to Whittingham Wildlife Management Area - Mayor Phillips referred to an email received from a Green Township resident expressing concerns of news about an aggressive bear being trapped in Morris County and assuming relocated to Whittingham Wildlife Management Area. The concern is surrounding municipalities (Fredon, Andover and Green) are left to deal with problem aggressive bears. The resident asked if the Mayors from Fredon, Andover and Green can take action to prevent Whittingham from being a dumping ground for these problem and aggressive bears. Mayor Phillips had asked Mrs. DeClesis to contact New Jersey Fish and Game. Mayor Phillips reviewed the information regarding the categories of bears named by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP). If the NJDEP determines that a bear is not in a suitable location, the bear would be captured and relocated to the nearest state land that is more suitable such as Whittingham, Clinton or Black River Wildlife Management Areas. If the bear is too aggressive, it would be euthanized, not relocated. A discussion ensued concerning the management of bears being relocated. The Committee directed Mr. Zschack to OPRA information from the State, such as the number of bears that have been relocated to Whittingham for aggressive behavior in the last ten years, the population control plan for the bears in Whittingham and the number of problem bears that have been euthanized.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK: Mr. Zschack noted the following matters:

Natural Gas Expansion - The plans received for the natural gas expansion in Lake Tranquility indicates mains to be installed in all roads on the northwest side of the lake. The mains will be installed approximately three feet off the edge of pavement. The Township Engineer will be working with the contractor to insure proper installation. American Rescue Plan - The Township has received a deposit of \$181,652.17 in American Rescue Plan funds. Over the next few months, the CFO and the Township Administrator will compile a list of potential expenditures for said funds.

Fire Department Check - At the previous meeting the Green Fire Department payment was removed from the bills list. Mr. Zschack asked if the Township Committee wishes to release said check. The Committee directed Mr. Zschack to continue to hold the check.

Miss Green - Miss Jennifer Ahmad was crowned Miss Green 2021 on June 25th. Jennifer will compete in the Queen of the Fair on Saturday, August 7, 2021.

Farmland Assessments - The deadline to submit the 2022 Farmland Assessment Applications is August 1st. There have been a few residents that have yet to receive the application by mail and have been informed that they are available on the website or in the municipal building.

Township Committee Special Meeting - Mr. Zschack asked the Committee for their recommendation on holding a Special Meeting virtually or live for Monday, July 26, 2021, to introduce a bond ordinance.

No further or additional refund of taxes shall be permitted, regardless of the date of the disability of the veteran as determined by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.
