DISCUSSIONS:

a. Scheduling and Reopening of Green Township - Mr. Zschack reviewed the Work Action Plan including guidelines for employees to return to full time status. The recommended start date for the DPW is tomorrow, June 16; the office staff as of July 6. The municipal building will reopen to the public with limited access on July 6 as well. Mr. Zschack reviewed the public access as well as protocols for returning to full time status. The Committee accepted and approved moving forward with the plan as outlined.

The Committee discussed the opening of Township parks and facilities and the following decisions were made:

- The Pavilion at EverGreen Park and the downstairs meeting room of the municipal building will open after July 6 with minimized occupancy. A suggestion was made to add a waiver to the Use of Facilities form that the Township is not liable for the potential COVID-19 exposure.
- EverGreen Park playground remains closed and will follow State regulations once the installation of the new playground has been completed.
- The Trinca Airport gate will remain closed.
- Live meetings Mr. Zschack stated that plexiglass shields and barriers have been installed at the dais. It is the Committee's opinion that live meetings can occur safely.
- **b.** Bench Donation Policy Mayor Phillips reviewed the revised Memorial Bench Program as discussed at the last meeting. A picture of the sample bench with the cost will be included as well as ideas for the location of the bench. The Committee members approve the policy.
- c. 2020 Budget and Expenditures (State Aid) Mr. Zschack stated that the Finance Subcommittee met and discussed the potential of a reduction in state aid for next year and also the possibility for this year. From the Current Fund Budget, the road repair line was scrutinized and the possibility of not utilizing the road repair monies this year and encumbering for next year could help if the state aid is reduced. The Committee is in agreement. Mr. Zschack reviewed the Capital Improvement Plan. The Subcommittee reviewed and discussed the monies budgeted for playground equipment, security camera, portable message board, and the asphalt roller. It is recommended to move the money allocated for the playground equipment back into the capital improvement surplus. The money can be utilized by a fully funded ordinance. The Committee members are in agreement that these items should be held until there is more clarification from the State.
- d. Cable TV Municipal Consent Mr. Zschack stated that according to the Franchise Renewal Timetable. Unfortunately, the notice 36 months prior to expiration date was missed. The Township Attorney explained that Altice's takeover of SCETV will be effective in July. A hearing is not expected until after that is finalized. The Township Attorney explained the process and the timeline. The franchise expired in February 2020. There are concerns of cable not reaching certain areas in the Township. This will have to be negotiated once Altice has taken over.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY SPECIAL USE PERMIT APPLICATIONS AND APPROVALS FOR RELIEF FROM TOWNSHIP ORDINANCES DUE TO LIMITATIONS ON BUSINESS OPERATIONS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, given the reduced risks of COVID-19 transmission outdoors, and pursuant to Executive Order No. 150, the New Jersey Governor has authorized restaurants, bars, and other food or beverage establishments to provide in-person service at areas designated for food and/or beverage consumption ("outdoor dining") in accordance with CDC and DOH safeguards, while still restricting indoor dining at this time; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order No. 150, establishments can only open to the public to offer outdoor dining or such food and/or beverage consumption as conducted in a way that ensures critical statewide health standards are met, standards which have been issued by the Department of Health; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Green wishes to provide commercial relief to the Township business by allowing the issuance of Temporary Special Use Permits for Relief from Township Ordinances Due to Limitations on Business Operations During the COVID-19 Pandemic, at no additional cost to Township businesses, so long as approved by the Zoning Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Green wishes to assist and approve proper applications filed for COVID-19 Expansion of Premises Permits for Plenary Retail Consumption Licenses with the ABC, for the purpose of temporarily expanding the premises under license wherein the sale, service and storage of alcoholic beverages are authorized.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Green in the County of Sussex and State of New Jersey that Temporary Special Use Permits for Relief From Township Ordinances Due to Limitations on Business Operations During the COVID-19 Pandemic shall be issued, upon proper application to the Zoning Officer, to grant relief from specific limitations so that businesses may conduct their operations out of doors during the COVID-19 pandemic subject to the following:

- 1. Each business seeking to take advantage of this special temporary relief shall complete a Temporary Special Use Permit application, to be submitted to and approved by the Township Zoning Officer.
- 2. This special temporary relief is to support business operations while applicable COVID-19 restrictions are in effect due to the Governor's Executive Orders or other federal or state requirements which are imposed due to COVID-19 pandemic. Any approval ultimately

granted, or a condition thereof, is subject to change upon the Governor's issuance of a modifying Executive Order, or federal or state requirements are added or changed.

- 3. Approval of said temporary relief does not relieve the applicant from any requirements of all other regulatory authorities (e.g., county, state, federal, ABC, DOH, FD, Fire Marshall, PD, UCC).
- 4. The Township Clerk is authorized to approve the temporary expansion of applications for Plenary Retail Consumption Licensed premises to place under license the area delineated in the application form to the ABC, effective through November 30, 2020.
- 5. Regardless of the foregoing, all temporary permits granted pursuant to this Resolution shall expire on January 1, 2021, unless extended or terminated by the Township Committee.
- 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase in this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution.
