MATTERS FROM THE GOVERNING BODY:

Mr. Conkling asked if the new garbage contract begins this week. Mr. Zschack confirmed that Blue Diamond Disposal will pick up the first collection on Thursday, March 5, 2020. Mr. Conkling asked if anyone has heard of the loss of state funding for the Green Township school. Mayor Phillips responded that Green lost a very small amount of state funding.

Mrs. Raffay commented that she has observed many tree trimming trucks in the area. Mrs. Raffay commented that she noticed several people walking their dogs on the walking path at EverGreen Park.

Mr. Conkling asked when the pavilion will reopen. Mr. Zschack will look into.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK: Mr. Zschack noted the following matters:

<u>Lawn Maintenance</u> - New Jersey Local Publics Contract Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15 allows for extension of contracts. The Township's QPA has stated that the existing Lawn Maintenance agreement with ACF Landscape Design, Inc can be extended for one or two years. ACF Landscape submitted a proposal for two years. In 2020 the cost will remain the same at \$44,165.00 and for the 2021 season cost will drop to \$38,640.00 (\$5,525 difference) anticipating not having to mow the airport property. A brief discussion ensued concerning the term of the contract and the mowing of the airport property. Mr. Zschack was directed to get a price for including mowing the airport property for the next Committee meeting.

<u>Lighting Complaint Block 33 Lot 1.06</u> - At the February 22, 2020, Township Committee meeting Mrs. Laura Bugay, 3 Fieldview Road, presented a handout regarding a complaint for the building on Airport Road across from the airport property. The Township Engineer performed a site inspection on February 25, 2020. The final report is yet to be completed however Mr. Stoner agrees with the lighting concerns. The current outside lighting fixtures do not match the Land Use Board's approvals. The contractor will install the proper downlighting that was approved.

Mr. Conkling commented that the lights at Tranquillity Farms are also very bright at night. Mr. Conkling suggested looking into the criteria

<u>Lake Tranquility Drainage</u> - The preliminary work involving the collection of field data for the Lake Tranquility Drainage study has started. To save time and money it was decided to perform some preliminary investigation in-house. This will allow Mr. Perigo to relay important past information and ensure the passage of critical information to the next generation of DPW managers. From the information gathered, Mr. Stoner will be able to establish a scope of work to submit a proposal.

<u>Use of Facilities</u> - The Township has received a Use of Facilities form from Pat Rizzuto, President of the Top of New Jersey R/C Club requesting the use of Trinca Airport, August 21-23, 2020. The event will benefit the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Sussex County. They expect to have a Saturday night BBQ dinner. This approval includes permission for recreational camping vehicles to stay overnight with no hook-ups. A municipal employee will be onsite for the setup and breakdown with cost covered by the organization. Based on past history, there have been no complaints with this event. Mr. Zschack stated that he will notify the Recreation Advisory Committee to see if they would like to do something along with this event. The Committee approved the event on the Trinca Airport property.

<u>Playground</u> - The new proposal for the playground covers:

• Demolition, Removal and Site Preparation

- Rubber Recycled Mulch (2' Top off)
- Equipment Components (Including New Swings)
- Installation of all Components
- Installation of 1' Trex Cap on Existing Wood Border

Total price is \$163,909.00. The total in reserve is \$125,000.00. The remaining \$39,000.00 can be utilized from the Capital Reserve Account. An ordinance will be on the agenda for consideration at the next meeting. The estimated completion date is by July of this year. Mr. Zschack reviewed the proposed equipment including a fully handicapped accessible section and swing. A letter of intent will be sent to the co-op company so the equipment can be ordered. The Committee authorized moving forward with the paperwork.

Mr. Conkling asked if any of this money can come from open space. The Township Attorney stated that the statute reads that open space money needs to be applied to property that was acquired using the fund.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP ATTORNEY: Mr. Frodella noted no matters to report.

MATTERS FROM THE MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT HEAD: Not in attendance

Mrs. Laura Bugay, 3 Fieldview Road, thanked the Committee for addressing the lighting at the building on Airport Road. Mrs. Bugay commented about the use of rubber mulch at the playground and the concern of the heat from the sun.

Mrs. Cathy Cooper, 22 Fieldview Road, asked if the properties near the rail trail can put a driveway across the trail. Mayor Phillips stated that the Township Committee would need to give permission since it is municipal property.

There being no further public comments offered, Mayor Phillips closed Open Public Session #2.

AN ORDINANCE REVISING SECTION 2-32, "EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL", OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREEN

WHEREAS, the Green Township Committee has reviewed the current Township Code regarding the Emergency Management Coordinator and Emergency Management Council and found that revisions are necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Green, Sussex County, New Jersey, that Chapter II, Administration, Article X, Office of Emergency Management, Sections 2-32.1 and 2-32.6, shall be revised as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 2-32.1 "Creation of Office", that reads:

2-32.1 Creation of Office.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. Appendix A:9-40.6, et seq., the Township Committee shall appoint an Emergency Management Coordinator who shall be a resident of the Township for three (3) years.

Shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

2.32.1 Creation of Office

In compliance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> Appendix A:9-40.1, the Township Mayor shall appoint an Emergency Management Coordinator, who shall be a resident of the Township for three (3) years. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall serve a three (3) year term and shall fulfill the requirements of applicable law.

SECTION 2.

Section 2.32.6 "Emergency Management Council", that reads:

2-32.6 Emergency Management Council.

An Emergency Management Council shall be created. The Emergency Management Council shall be composed of not more than fifteen (15) members who shall be appointed by the Township Committee and shall hold office at the will and pleasure of the Township Committee. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall be a member and shall serve as chairman of the Emergency Management Council. The Emergency Management Council shall perform such duties as required in accordance with the State Statutes and pursuant to the Emergency Management Master Plan on file at the Township of Green.

Shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

2.32.6 Emergency Management Council.

An Emergency Management Council shall be created. The Emergency Management Council shall be composed of not more than fifteen (15) members who shall be appointed by the Township Mayor and shall hold office at the will and pleasure of the Township Committee. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall be a member and shall serve as Chairman of the Emergency Management Council. The Emergency Management

Council shall perform such duties as required in accordance with the State Statutes and pursuant to the Emergency Management Master Plan on file at the Township of Green.

SECTION 3.

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are inconsistent or in opposition to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication and passage according to law.

Section 4. No officer or employee shall be entitled to receive an additional increment of salary until the same has been approved by resolution of the Township Committee.

Section 5. The Township Committee reserves the right to pay a salary to any new employee during his or her probationary period of ninety (90) days which may be less than the minimum rate of salary or compensation as herein above provided. However, upon the satisfactory completion of such probationary period said employee shall be paid not less than the minimum salary provided for the particular office or employment.

Section 6. The Township Committee further reserves the right to pay a salary to any new employee at any figure between the minimum and maximum salary provided for such office or position and not necessarily the minimum salary.

Section 7. The adoption of this Ordinance shall not operate to either increase or decrease the present pay of any officer or employee of the Township of Green, and the salaries or compensations provided by existing ordinances shall remain in full force and effect until such time as the Township Committee may grant and approve such additional increments of salary as may be deemed advisable

WHEREAS, the Township's Airport Manager, Pete Sklannik, Jr., will coordinate any additional follow up regarding the airport closure with the NJDOT Bureau of Aeronautics, the Federal Aviation Administration and any other governmental office or department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Green, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey that:

- 1. Trinca Airport shall be closed as an airport effective as of September 30, 2020, provided that the Township of Green will have no continuing liability, financial or otherwise under any grants.
- 2. The Mayor is authorized to sign a letter, as well as any other documents, in order to notify the NJDOT Bureau of Aeronautics, as well as the Federal Aviation Administration and any other governmental office or department with jurisdiction over the Airport of the closing.
