The Committee would prefer the meeting to be held on Tuesday, April 9. Mr. Zschack will follow-up with the BOE President.

Post Office Sale

The Township has received an inquire into the possible sale of the Post Offices. Does the Township Committee want to consider this or should it be vetted in the Buildings and Grounds Committee? A brief discussion was held and the Committee is not interested at this time.

LOSAP

The Allamuchy Mayor contacted Mayor Conkling to discuss the possibility of providing funds for LOSAP to the First Aid Squad. At this time, it appears that Allamuchy would need to pass a referendum allowing payments and only then can the two municipalities discuss any agreement if wanted. Mayor Conkling further explained that he asked the Allamuchy Township Attorney to contact Green Township Attorney. Mrs. Leo stated that there are a lot of requirements and procedures from LOSAP. Mrs. Leo is in the process of researching these requirements.

Cell Tower DPW

The Township has been informed that American Tower is proposing a co-location with AT&T on the cell tower located on Township property. This would increase the amount of rent the Township receives. We are in the process of contacting American Tower to work out a Tri-Party lease agreement.
