- ~Contestants must be willing to represent Green Township at the NJ State Fair/ Sussex County Farm and Horse Show as well as other community events.
- ~All contestants must dress in formal wear (long gown preferred, if possible, but not required).

Queen of the Fair Information:
2026 Fair dates

Friday, July 31st - Saturday, August 8th

Queen of the Fair Pageant - Saturday, August 1st

Requirements:

All contestants must be 17 but not yet reached their 22nd birthday by August 1st. Proof of age may be required.

All must be bona fide year-round residents of Sussex County. Proof of residency may be required.

All contestants will wear formal evening attire and a sash representing their municipality.

All Contestants have never represented her town before in the Queen of the Fair pageant.

If selected as "Queen of the Fair" you **must** be available to represent the Fair at several functions throughout the year including the remaining 7 days (after crowning) of the New Jersey State Fair/Sussex County Farm and Horse Show.

The completed application and any revisions must be submitted no later than July 1, 2026. All information on application may be used for publicity.
