CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Phillips called the October 4, 2021, meeting of the Green Township Committee to order at 7:00 p.m.

OPEN PUBLIC SESSION #1 Mayor Phillips opened the meeting to the public for any questions or comments concerning items on the agenda for which no public discussion is provided. There being no comments offered, Mayor Phillips closed Open Public Session #1.

PRESENTATION OF CERTIFICATES OF APPRECIATION AND RECOGNITION TO CLEAN COMMUNITIES 2021 PARTICIPATING GROUPS - Since no groups were present to receive their certificates, Mayor Phillips read the name of each group that participated and thanked them for helping to keep Green clean!

PUBLIC AUCTION: Block 116, Lot 1 Minimum Sale Price \$34,000.00 - The Township Attorney stated the property being sold is located at 190 Kennedy Road, Block 116, Lot 1, 1.06 acres unapproved lot, with a minimum sale price of \$34,000.00. The property is sold in accordance with the Township Resolution 2021-143. The notice was duly advertised and published. The Township Attorney opened the bidding with a minimum sale price of \$34,000.00 and asked for bidders.

Mr. Robert Boyle of Planet Networks, Inc. offered a bid of \$34,000.00. The Township Attorney noted that no one else expressed an interest in the property. As such the property is sold to Mr. Boyle for \$34,000.00. The sale is complete and subject to confirmation by the Township Committee by resolution at the next Committee meeting.

Mayor Phillips asked Mr. Boyle to share with the Committee the direction Planet Networks is going with expansion in the Township. Mr. Boyle provided an update on Planet Networks fiber optic installation in Green Township.

MATTERS FROM THE TOWNSHIP CLERK: Mr. Zschack noted the following matters:

Road Condition on County Route 611 - The following reply from the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners was received:

“Acknowledging receipt of your September 20, 2021 letter to the Board of County Commissioners regarding a dangerous road condition on County Route 611. This correspondence has been forwarded to the Board of County Commissioners and the Department of Engineering.”

Gas Expansion Lake Tranquility - The Lake Tranquility project has started its third week of installation. Work resumed on Scenic Drive where rock was encountered last week. Sporadic areas of rock have reduced daily footage install totals. The two main areas of focus last week were on the 2” main install on Scenic as well as on Crescent Road along with rock break and removal. This week the contractor will continue its install of 2” PE main on Scenic Drive as well as Crescent Road. The rock that is being encountered is in some spots extremely difficult to hammer out and will continue next week.

Whitehall Road Pave & Mill - The guide rail on Whitehall Road has been installed. We have received some concerns about the patch that was redone from Township Committee members, therefore the Township Engineer will inspect and issue a memo.

MATTERS FROM THE GOVERNING BODY: Mr. Conkling commented that the new DPW employee is doing an excellent job with roadside mowing. Mayor Phillips concurred.

Mr. Conkling commented on the patch on Whitehall Road.

Mr. Conkling commented that Green Township was a great day. Kudos to the Recreation Committee and everyone responsible for putting it on. The DPW employees was doing a very diligent job in keeping everything clean.

Mrs. Raffay also commented that Green Township was a great day and thought the helicopter was awesome. She received positive feedback from the vendors.

Mayor Phillips thanked the Recreation Committee, Mr. Zschack, Mr. Proshuto (DPW), for everyone’s work in organizing Green Township Day. And kudos to Mr. Rose for arranging the helicopter land in the park. Mayor Phillips commented that the food vendors prices were too high.

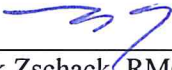

WHEREAS, the Township will receive a Check for \$181,652.27 from the Department of the Treasury, State of New Jersey and wishes to amend its 2021 Budget to include this amount as revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the Budget of the year 2021 for a sum of \$181,652.27 which item is now available as a revenue from:

Special Items of General Revenue Anticipated with Prior Written
Consent of the Director of Local Government Services:
Public and Private Revenues Offset with Appropriation
American Rescue Plan

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a like sum of \$181,652.27 be and the same is hereby appropriated under the caption of:

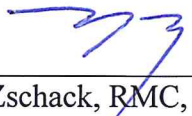

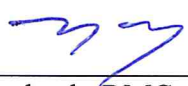

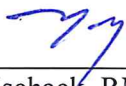
WHEREAS, an application has been received with a request to install two memorial benches at Pittenger Park from Theresa Goarcke Ayers;

Location of Benches

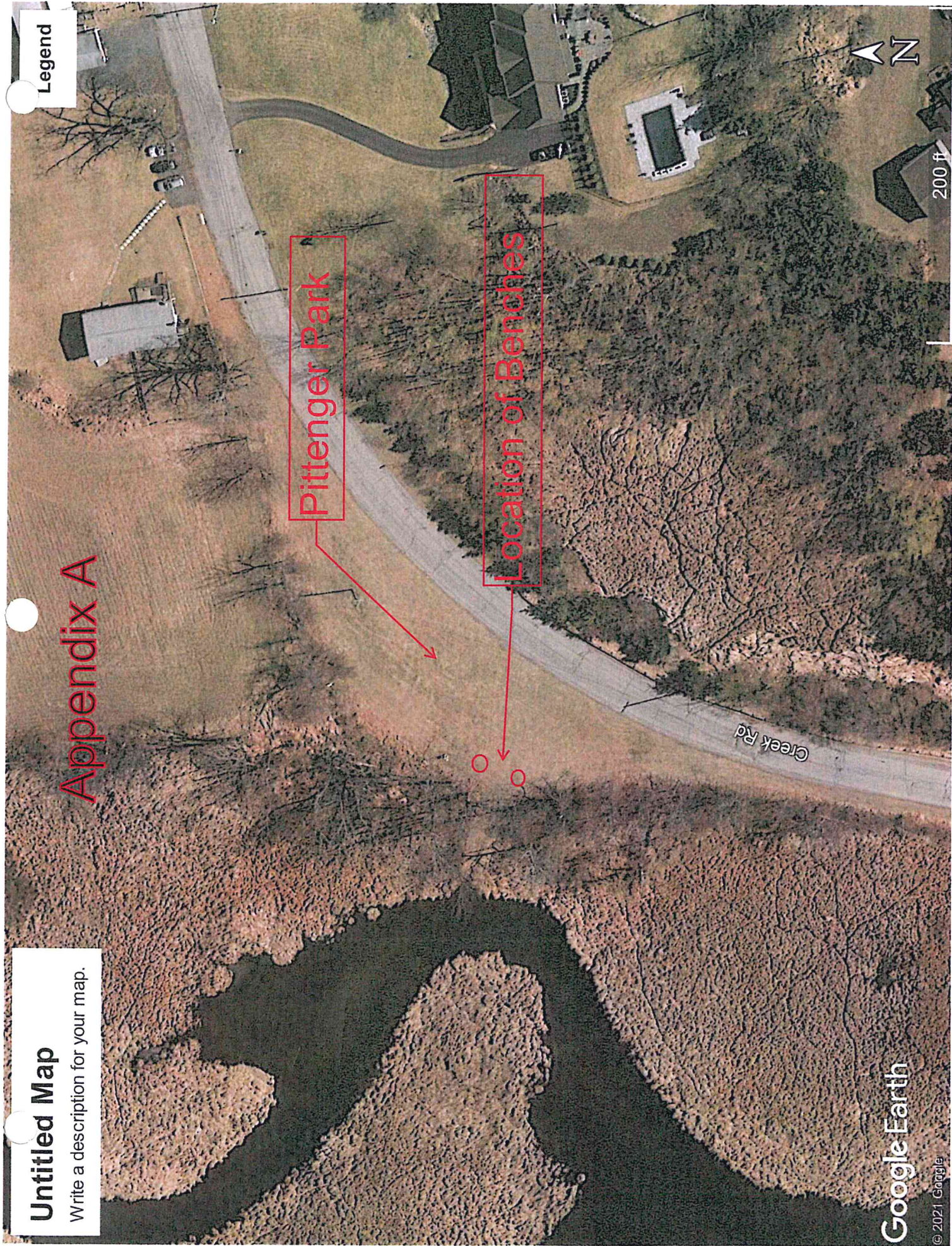

SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE
GREEN HILLS SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR FUEL
